See the **city hall** (16th century), the **Palazzo della Ragione** (13th century), the **Piazza della Erbe** and the **Piazza delle Fruta** as well as the Neo-

Classicist café Pedrocchi (19th century).

Passing Verona we travel from through the Valpollicella wine country to Lake Garda, largest of the Italian lakes. The lake shores are dotted with cypresses, olive groves, vineyards and flowering shrubs. Lunch on your own

houses, winding alleys, enchanting courtyards, renaissance palaces, and - perhaps the most famous of Verona's sights - the houses of Romeo and Juliet. Standing below **Juliet's balcony**, you can almost picture her appearing from her room and calling out to Romeo.
