Arrive in **Eisenstadt** - where Joseph Haydn lived for 30 years. Eisenstadt is the capital as well as the cultural and educational center of the province of Burgenland. This charming Baroque town - its buildings influenced by the Prince Esterhazy dynasty - is Austria's smallest and youngest provincial capital. Eisenstadt had its heyday in the 18th century when it was ruled by Prince Nikolaus Esterhazy. See the **Esterhazy Palace** where Haydn conducted the court orchestra almost every evening.

Continue to **Oberschützen** and meet with your hosts – **the Oberschützen Institute orchestra**, a branch of the **University of Music and Dramatic Arts** in **Graz** which is the second largest town in Austria and an important center for science and cultural activities.
